The Fed's Battle to Achieve a Soft-Landing in 2022 – What Are the Chances?

We are into the third year of the Covid Pandemic, and it is now clear the fiscal and monetary stimuli applied to defeat the economic downturn caused by the virus



was way too strong. In late 2021, the Fed announced a major policy pivot away from fighting the high unemployment caused by the Covid recession to combating the highest inflation this nation has experienced in decades. In addition, the current Russian invasion of Ukraine has caused additional inflationary pressures to erupt in the energy and commodity sectors, with certain commodities reaching historic record highs. The most important issue at this moment is how the Federal Reserve will respond to the current inflationary spiral. Can the Fed combat current inflation without weakening the economy so much as to cause another recession, the so-called soft landing? Dr Ed will discuss all the monetary policy weapons that the Fed will deploy to fight this inflation monster. Higher policy rates and changes in the Fed's balance sheet will work to slow inflation but will also create new forces that may impact the economy in unforeseen ways.
