3rd Year BankExec Presentation Assignment

To cap off your 3rd year of Bank School, you will be responsible for presenting what you learned through the BankExec program to two of the fellows with whom you will be working all week. The fellows are looking forward to a dialogue focused on your learning outcomes and are also looking forward to answering your lingering questions.

ASSIGNMENT

Create a presentation in the form of a dialogue based on the performance and current standing of your bank. Include in your conversation the challenges you faced over the last two years, your key decision points that resulted in your bank's current financial performance, and your learning outcomes from the experience. Use the following questions to guide your discussion:

- What were your biggest challenges?
- What were your biggest victories?
- What were the key decision points that resulted in your bank's current financial performance?
 - O What decision had a better outcome than you expected? What did you learn?
 - What decision resulted in an outcome that wasn't as favorable as you expected? What did you learn?
- What lessons learned through BankExec can you take home and implement in your regular job?

PRESENTATION

Each team will be presenting in front of all teams in their individual community beginning at 10:30 am on Friday, July 31. You will have a chance to work with your team for presentation planning on Thursday afternoon from 3:00-4:00 pm and final planning and practice from 9:00-10:30 am on Friday morning. You will use the same BankExec decisions Zoom link for these practice sessions.

Presentation must take no longer than 15 minutes, including Q&A time with the fellows, to present. Presentation materials like PowerPoint slides or other visuals are not required. If you would like to have a visual, we have created a PowerPoint slide template for your use.

The presentations will take place over Zoom. If you use the template PowerPoint slide, we will ask that one of your team members share his/her screen. A VBA staff member will be present to help with the technology.
