To cap off your 3<sup>rd</sup> year of Bank School, you will be responsible for presenting what you learned through the BankExec program to two of the fellows. The fellows are looking forward to a dialogue focused on your learning outcomes and are also looking forward to answering your lingering questions.

## **ASSIGNMENT**

Create a presentation in the form of a dialogue based on the performance and current standing of your bank. Include in your conversation the challenges you faced over the last two years, your key decision points that resulted in your bank's current financial performance, and your learning outcomes from the experience. Use the following questions to guide your discussion:

- What were your biggest challenges?
- What were your biggest victories?
- What were the key decision points that resulted in your bank's current financial performance?
  - What decision had a better outcome than you expected? What did you learn?
  - What decision resulted in an outcome that wasn't as favorable as you expected? What did you learn?
- What lessons learned through BankExec can you take home and implement in your regular job?

Teams will present to a group of the fellows on Thursday afternoon, July 28, 2022 beginning at 2:45 pm (see presentation schedule below). Presentations will take place in your own team rooms – the fellows will visit your team room for your presentation at your designated time.
