COVID-19 Safety Protocols

2022 Virginia Bankers School of Bank Management Code of Conduct Agreement

We are excited to welcome you in person to the Virginia Bankers School of Bank Management (Bank School)! To ensure that we provide you with a safe and comfortable learning and networking environment, we have developed safety protocols that are compliant with the guidelines set forth by the [Virginia Department of Health](#). As a condition of participating in Bank School and its associated activities, we ask that you sign the following agreement and agree to follow our Code of Conduct safety protocols **by Wednesday, July 20th**.

Coronavirus (or COVID-19) is a viral infection that can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death. It spreads when an infected person breathes out droplets and very small particles that contain the virus. These droplets and particles can be breathed in by other people or land on their eyes, noses, or mouth. In some circumstances, they may contaminate surfaces they touch. People who are closer than six (6) feet from the infected person are most likely to get infected. Individuals can be infected with COVID-19 and show no symptoms, but still spread the disease.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

I agree to abide by and follow the following Code of Conduct and all safety protocols:

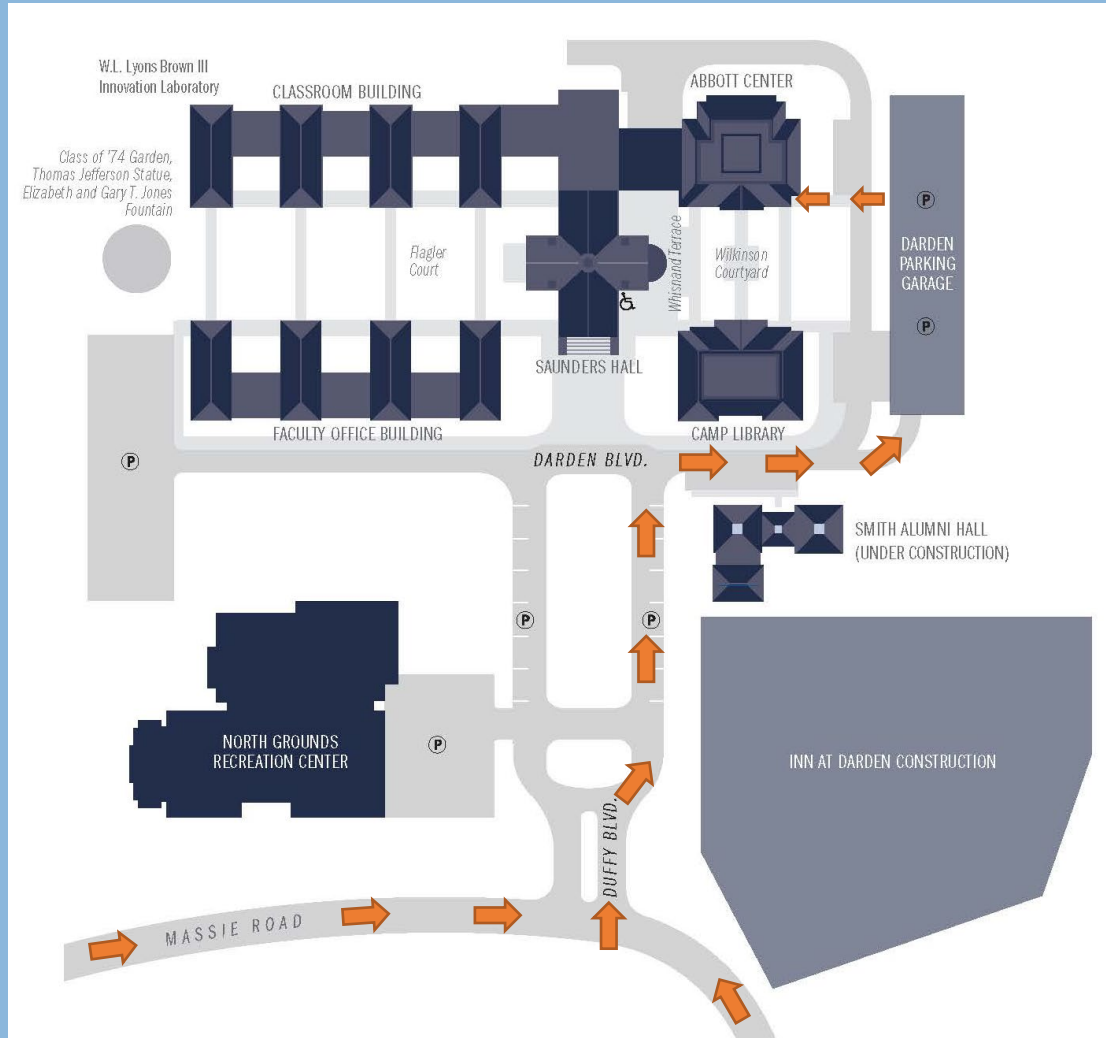
In the days leading up to Bank School week and each day at Bank School, please monitor your health. If you are feeling ill (cough, fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, sore throat, difficulty breathing, stomach distress, loss of taste or smell, fatigue, headache, or muscle or body aches), immediately isolate yourself from others, stay at home/in your hotel room, seek appropriate medical advice, and contact a member of the VBA Bank School staff to inform them of your illness. Students are responsible for obtaining their own COVID-19 testing.

COVID-19 EXPOSURE: "Close contact" is defined by the CDC as being within 6 feet of a COVID-19 infected

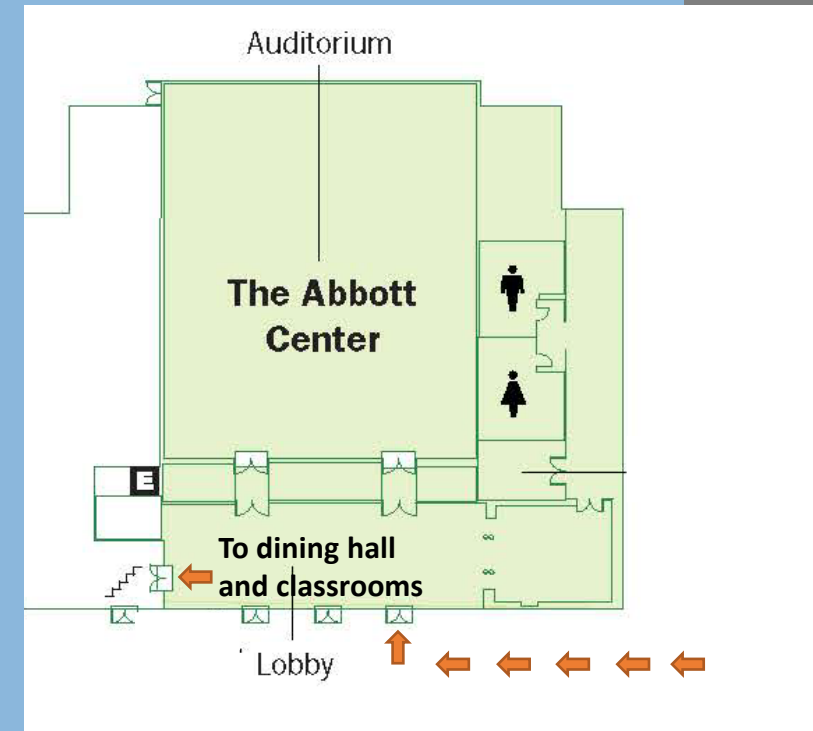

Class Officer Roles, Responsibilities & Elections

CLASS OFFICER ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The class officer slate is comprised of four positions: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. While these positions work together as a team, there are still individual responsibilities that each officer has in mind.

President

As president, you will be responsible for organizing the team to accomplish tasks. You will be serving as the liaison between the VBA and your class while school is in session. During the school year, you will keep the class informed of upcoming events, changes in the schedule, etc. For example, you will attend daily class meetings, newsletters, etc. It is important to remember that you are the face of the class and need to hear from you. In between sessions, the president maintains contact with the class through the secretary. Past classes have utilized group chat apps and monthly newsletters as a means of contact. Your overall goal is to keep the lines of communication open and the goals of the class on track.

Vice President

The vice president serves as the catch-all. With so many things going on at the same time, the vice president has to be ready to act in the capacity of class president in the event the president is unable to attend. In addition, the vice president assists in the coordination of the 3rd year party. Along with the president, the vice president is responsible for recruiting volunteers who want to help with class initiatives.

Secretary

The secretary is responsible for maintaining the current student roster for your class in conjunction with the VBA, handling class correspondence, etc. Past secretaries have also created "get to know your classmates" interviews.

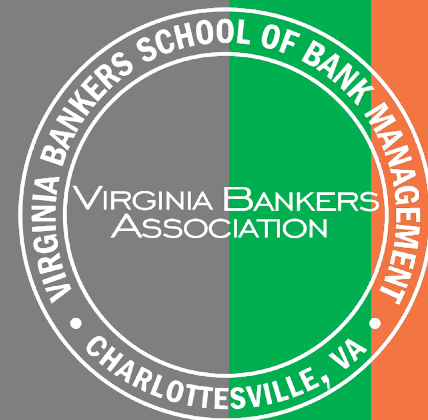
