To ensure that we provide you with a safe and comfortable learning and networking environment, we have developed safety protocols that are compliant with the guidelines set forth by the <u>Virginia Department of Health</u>. Coronavirus (or COVID-19) is a viral infection that can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death. It spreads when an infected person breathes out droplets and very small particles that contain the virus. These droplets and particles can be breathed in by other people or land on their eyes, noses, or mouth. In some circumstances, they may contaminate surfaces they touch. People who are closer than six (6) feet from the infected person are most likely to get infected. Individuals can be infected with COVID-19 and show no symptoms, but still spread the disease.


CODE OF CONDUCT:

I agree to abide by and follow the following Code of Conduct and all safety protocols:




