
Bank Day will take place on Tuesday, March 15th!

The third Tuesday in March was declared Bank Day by the Virginia General Assembly in 1991. Through this program, Virginia high school seniors learn about banking, financial services, career opportunities in the industry and the vital role banks play in their communities. From their experience, the students are required to write an essay and a total of \$25,000 in college scholarships are awarded to twelve students.
