


COVID-19 VACCINE UNIT KEY SYSTEMS: VAMS

As the Commonwealth of Virginia rapidly mobilizes vaccine operations and distribution, this one-pager can be used as an introduction to VAMS. We are grateful to have you on board as we make Virginia's vaccination campaign a success.

PURPOSE & IMPACT

Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS) is a web-based system that allows jurisdictions and clinics to support vaccination operations for critical populations. It is a clinical system that records vaccine administration events, and it sends the vaccine data to VIIS and allows providers to fulfill all federal data and reporting requirements.



USERS & KEY ROLES



Jurisdictions

- ✓ Create the creates the clinic, clinic administrator, and employer coordinator accounts



Vaccination Clinic Team Members

- ✓ Clinic administrators: set up the clinic and assign inventory manager roles, healthcare professionals, and front desk roles as necessary
- ✓ Clinic team members: use VAMS during clinic hours to report administration of vaccines



Organizations & Employers

- ✓ Register their organizations in VAMS and set up recipients prior to the clinic by uploading the required information into VAMS



Vaccine Recipient

- ✓ Complete registration, appointment scheduling, and questionnaires in VAMS
- ✓ Access notifications and update their information as necessary in the Recipient Portal

KEY FUNCTIONALITY



Data Capture

- VAMS captures and sends all required COVID-19 data to the CDC and VIIS



Inventory Order, Tracking, & Accountability

- VAMS provides ordering and tracking for inventory and has dose-level accountability



Real-Time Reporting

- VAMS can provide real-time reporting through queries



Notifications and Registrations

- VAMS can send reminders to vaccine recipients for follow-up appointments
